Primary Duties:

- Reports directly to SHO Board of Directors
- Creates and executes yearly operational farm plan with SHO Board oversight
- Manages hourly farm labor & signs off on timesheets
- Directs planting, maintenance of crops, harvesting and preparation of produce for market (CSA, retail and wholesale)
- Develops markets for SHO products/services and expands sales opportunities
- Tends to onsite livestock as needed
- Maintains & strengthens relationships with existing and new customers
- Travels to markets and to acquire needed equipment
- Maintains farm records for accounting, analysis, organic certification, etc.
- Maintains farm log, provides status reports to SHO board meetings, uses SHO online project management/communication tools.

General Responsibilities:

The Farm manager will have primary responsibility for:

- Efficient, cost-effective and profitable operations of farm
- Overall health and maintenance of the crops
- Hiring, management, oversight and performance evaluation of subordinate farm work staff and interns/apprentices.
- Condition (appearance, aesthetics, accessibility, safety) of the farm
- Care and maintenance of farm equipment, buildings, tools and others assets
- Bringing new ideas and trends in the practice and marketing of local, organic agriculture to the SHO Board for consideration.
- Other duties as needed

Job Requirements:

- Enthusiasm about farm work, organic agriculture and making a difference
- Demonstrated leadership & management experience
- Strong interpersonal and communication (verbal and written) skills
- Solid organizational, project management and time management skills
- Overall good health and strength
- Tolerant of heat, cold, moisture, dirt and outdoor allergies
- Flexible schedule: able to schedule around weather and work early mornings, late evenings, and as needed on planned or emergency bases.
- Responsible for own transportation
